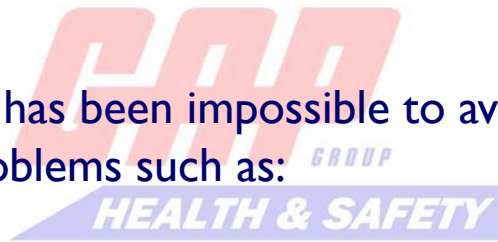


Don't try to be slick!

In Recent years it has been impossible to avoid hearing about the global environmental problems such as:

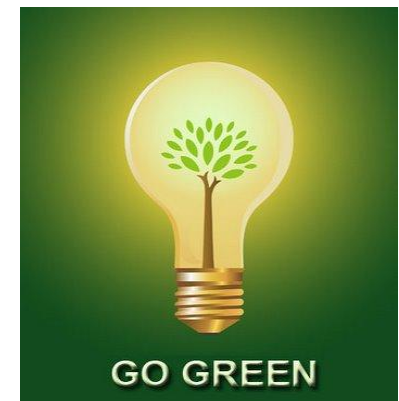
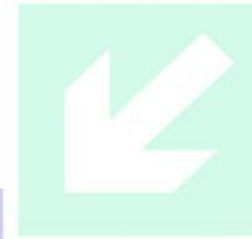
- Global Warming

Moral

All businesses use energy, water and materials such as paper.

If each UK company made just 5 fewer photocopies per day, we would save 2,500,000 reams of paper. This would mean:


- Felling 200,000 fewer trees.
- Reducing the amount of landfill space being taken up.
- Reducing the amount of process energy, chemicals and transpo involved in paper manufacture.
